“OBSESSIVE PLEASURES,” Pavel Zoubok, 1014 Madison Avenue, near 78th Street, (212) 879-5858 (through May 24). More cheerfully overwrought than obsessive, the works in this theme show include Thomas Lanigan-Schmidt’s circular collages of foil, plastic and colored pipe cleaners; Barbara Takenaga’s cosmic dot paintings; Daniel Zeller’s finely lined drawings, like zany topographical maps; Amy Yoes’s paintings of ruffles, stripes, blossoms and architectural elements; John Digby’s cut-out vines; Nora Aslan’s extremely dense yet expansive flower collages; Aric Obrosey’s laceworks; and Christopher Tanner’s glittery paisley patterns (Ken Johnson).
